Amending Quota Policy No. 170-2005

Effective February 18, 2010

Made under: The Farm Products Marketing Act

Chicken Farmers of Ontario Quota Policy No. 170-2005 is hereby amended:

1. At section 2.08, by removing the words “a market weight incentive” in the second line; and add the words “an overmarketing” after the word undermarketing.
2. At section 2.09, by removing the words “less the sum of all amounts fixed and allotted as a market weight incentive” in the fourth line;
3. At section 2.21, by adding the words “or cycle” after the word “week” in the fifth line;
4. At section 2.32, by adding the words “and any other applicable CFO policies or regulations” at the end of the section;
5. At section 3.17, by adding the words “where 0.65 is based on an eight (8) week cycle and a stocking density of 31 kg/m² (2.88 kg/ft²) (6.35lb/ft²)” at the end of the section;
6. At section 6.10, by removing “Ontario Turkey Producers’ Marketing Board” and substituting “Turkey Farmers of Ontario” therefor and by removing “Ontario Egg Producers’ Marketing Board” and substituting therefor “Egg Farmers of Ontario”;
7. At section 7.02, by removing the word “and” in the first line and substituting therefor the word “or” and by removing the word “incidents” in the fourth line and substituting therefor the word “Form”;
8. By revising Schedule A as follows:

Schedule A

The maximum additional crop quota, market development crop quota, missed additional crop quota, undermarketing and overmarketing that may be fixed and allotted in respect of a producer's premises for any crop quota period may be determined as follows:

$$ACQ = 2.88(APS - (0.65 \times BQ))^1$$

where;

ACQ is the maximum additional crop quota, market development crop quota, missed additional crop quota, undermarketing and overmarketing

APS is the approved production space on the premises

BQ is the basic quota fixed and allotted in respect of the premises

The above formula may also be expressed as follows:

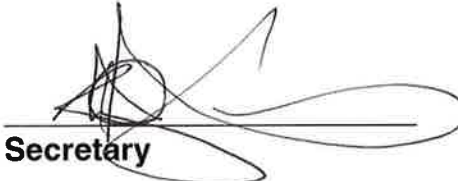
1. Multiply the basic quota fixed and allotted in respect of the premises by 0.65¹;
2. Subtract the product obtained in 1. above from the approved production space on the premises;
3. Multiply the result in 2. by 2.88¹;
4. The product obtained in 3. is the maximum additional crop quota, market development crop quota, missed additional crop quota, undermarketing and overmarketing (in kilograms) that may be fixed and allotted in respect of the premises pursuant to this Quota Policy.

¹ Based on an eight (8) week cycle and a stocking density of 31 kg/m² (2,88 kg/ft²) (6.35lb/ft²)
