
**Amending Chicken Farmers of Ontario Regulation No. 2072-2005 (Requirements
for the Marketing of Chicken by Producers to Out-of-Province Processors)**

1. Section 4 of Chicken Farmers of Ontario Regulation No. 2072-2005 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following subsections:
 - 4.20 Notwithstanding subsections 4.01 and 4.02 of this Regulation, commencing with Quota Period A-96, no applications and agreements made on Form 101A will be accepted or approved by the Board.
 - 4.21 Notwithstanding any other provision in this Regulation to the contrary, commencing in Quota Period A-96, the Board will decline to accept any agreements for the production and marketing of chicken made on Form 101 with an out-of-province processor:
 - (i) if such agreement is completed by a producer whose most recent previous marketing of chicken was to an Ontario processor; or
 - (ii) if such agreement is completed by a producer who has not previously marketed chicken pursuant to a crop quota fixed and allotted by the Board.
