Producer Margin

The producer margin is adjusted once every six Quota Periods to include changes in the costs of production except for feed and chick costs. The procedure is as follows:

- Use 1990 Cost of Production (COP) as base; Update prices using Statistics Canada data
- Compare average prices of recent six Quota Periods to average of previous six Quota Periods and apply difference to Producer Margin in previous six Quota Periods.
- Current Producer Margin 44.31 cents / kg;

Note: From A-88 to A-91, the live price will include a 'service charge' of \$0.001/kg. This service charge' is CFO's temporary mechanism to recover the expenses incurred from the Producer Cost Survey. Processors will collect the service charge with the Producer Levy effective from the beginning of A-88 to the end of A-91. The Producer Levy of \$0.0125/kg and the service charge of \$0.001/kg are collected together for a total of \$0.0135/kg.

Change: $-\$ 45.61$

\$5/Tonne = $1\phi / \text{kg LP}$

Change in LP= $- 9.12 \phi / \text{kg}$

Chick Price

A-88: 63.08¢

A-89: 61.12¢

Change: $- 1.96\phi$

$1\phi / \text{chick} = 0.5\phi / \text{kg LP}$

Change in LP = $- 0.98\phi / \text{kg}$
